str N-S mag, dip, 20° - v.
shale 32 mag. ...
Bank bearing, strike-slip 230°.

Rock is q. ...
dark coloured c. ben. flsp
& qtz & pyro. Petrographically
purple. ... Rock has a
pale color, due to alignment
of feldspars, N-S mag, 20° v
to west. ...
are aligned in same direction.
Here & there are bands a
few inches wide, where flsp.
is light grey colored, but
matrix is same as the
rock. Edges of band fairly
sharp.

Inclusions include a
pink v. q. granite, reddish
flap up to 3-4" ...
& some bit; dark fl. 60

upon which; light colored
qtz - flap - pyrox. vein is a
piece (diff. in direction to that
of vein), e.g. pyrox.
squares (small) + some
of qtz. flaps. squares (also
small).

All incl. sharp edged.
In places in the horn are
pink. heat plates an inch
across, and in places
also some scattered joints.

The light colored patches
are prob. a weathering
effect, as they seem to be
only a thin skin. Possibly
due to chipping of the flaps.
Deviations by ice. Snowing
occurs in several places.

Rock under etc.

One thin (1") pink qz.
qtz - flap. vein, straight,
uniform in width.

Henry Co. 24/60

consists of two veins, each
abt 35' apart rounded slabs
and a small slab (spec)
of the westernmost vein
thick on eastern (mag) is
pinkish grey porph. gran.
(spec) c. along fol. N350
(mag) west. felsp. phen are
up to 1 1/2" across, but
mostly rather smaller.
Inclusions are common,
mostly lg. but with such
a few miles across, oval
c. sharp edges. No alignment
of mil. along fol. A few
thin, str. sharp edged of-
felsp. veins, abt an inch
wide, part. bedded; some
mil. 18" across, of v. lg. but
gran (c. peg).
P. report of phen, in gran
veins somewhat from phen.

to place, but mostly being a
large proportion of the rock
going to widely spaced.
Major dikes NE (1000) &
another at rt. angles; both
vert.

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
